

## Sandford St Martin 2023 Awards

## **Eligibility Criteria**

- All entries must have been broadcast for the first time between 1 January and 31 December 2022 and should be sent to us 'as transmitted'. Please do not submit compilations.
- Entries will be accepted from UK or ROI-based broadcasting organisations, news providers, freelance technicians, and independent producers. Entries must have been publicly available to a UK audience.
- All entries and programme files must be completed and received by midnight on Sunday 29 January 2023. Please note this deadline is final and late entries are barred automatically.
- Non-English content must be either dubbed or subtitled in English.
- Individual production units can make a maximum of 2 entries (in any combination of one-off or series entries) from any titled series or strand, in each of the categories.
- Do not enter the same content in more than one category. If you are unsure which category is the most appropriate for your entry, please contact the Awards Administrator at <a href="mailto:admin@sandfordawards.org.uk">admin@sandfordawards.org.uk</a>.
- Please note, if your entry is shortlisted for an award, we will require a HD (video) or WAV (audio) copy of your entry before you can progress to the final judging stage.
- Submission of your entry acknowledges the right of The Sandford St Martin Trust to use the programme as required in connection with judging, promotion, and presentation of the Awards.
- There is no entry fee.
