

Sandford St Martin Trust suggested amendment to THE MEDIA BILL

(for Report stage, January 30, 2024)

Suggested amendment to:

Clause 1, page 3, line 11: leave out subsection (6) and insert—

- "(6) The requirements in this subsection are that—
 - (a) the range of audiovisual content genres made available by the public service broadcasters (taken together) will include but not be limited to programmes about
 - (i) religion and other beliefs,
 - (ii) science,
 - (iii) culture and arts,
 - (iv) social issues,
 - (v) matters of international significance, and
 - (vi) matters of specialist interest.
 - (b) there be a sufficient quantity and range of programmes within each genre."

Member's Explanatory Note:

This amendment would require Ofcom to report on whether public service broadcasters have made available an appropriate amount and range of programmes <u>in named socially valuable public service</u> <u>genres</u>, including programmes about religion and other beliefs which are currently at risk.
